

In ancient churches, Stained glass windows were the first public 'picture books' of the Bible. As far back as 350 A.D., stained glass windows in churches served a catechetical purpose by visually tell Biblical stories about God, spirituality, mortality and humanity. As the art form and architecture evolved, windows became more prominent in the great cathedrals of Europe and today are still used in churches of all sizes and denominations throughout the world—still serving that catechetical role of spreading the good news of our salvation through art.
